## **SCHOLARSHIP**



The Inter Valley Conference Scholarship is designed to recognize and promote academic excellence by all member school athletes. The IVC awards the "IVC Scholarship" to one male and one female athlete each school year. A selection committee, chosen by the Executive Committee, and chaired by the President-Elect will determine the recipients of the scholarship.

## **CRITERIA**

The criteria for the selection of the recipients is as follows:

- Each school is allowed to nominate one (1) male and one (1) female student-athlete.
- The applicant must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.500 on an unweighted grade point system as of the end of the first semester of his/her senior year.
- The applicant must have lettered in two (2) different sports and a minimum of one (1) letter must be earned prior to the senior year.
- An essay must be included in the application process.
- Additional criteria can be established by the Executive Committee.
